ITEM 1: ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

A. ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES FOR FY 2021-2022 (continued)

Leanna Ambersley presents the estimated administrative expenses, which do not include investment fees, since H&H has stated they are already calculated into the ADEC. Attorney Kone suggests adding another \$18,000 to the expenses to show the yearly cost more accurately for medical expenses (in comparison to other year's).

MOTION: Made by Trustee Ribeiro to approve the administrative expenses for submission for the Mayor's budget of \$284,200, suggested by attorney Kone.

MOTION SECONDED: by Trustee McDermott

<u>DISCUSSION:</u> by Trustee Cousins to have the administrative expenses spreadsheet reflect the \$284,200. The Trustees also discuss during what month, annually, these expenses should be voted on.

<u>AMENDED MOTION</u>: by Trustee Ribeiro to add that on an annual basis, this is submitted in December for review.

B. DISCUSS THE H&H 2020 EXPERIENCE STUDY TO ESTABLISH THE INVESTMENT RATE OF RETURN AND TO ESTABLISH THE ACTUARILY DETERMINED EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTION (continued)

Michael Gormany suggests (City recommendation as an alternative solution) 7.25% Rate of Return instead of the 7% as H&H had suggested (goes down from currently 7.75%), and to also stay at 2.5% inflation rate, instead of 1.25%.

<u>MOTION:</u> Made by Trustee Cousin to accept the city's recommendation to keep the inflator rate constant, to decrease the rate of return from 7.75 to 7.25%, and other than those two items, to fully adopt the other recommendations from Hooker and Holcombe in the Experience Study.
