## BACKGROUND

The City is requesting funds from FEMA for the purchase of a personnel accountability system which will enable command staff to identify the location of personnel while engaged in emergency operations. If the grant proposal is approved, the federal share of the project would be \$361,092; the City's local match will be \$36,109.

## PLANNING CONSIDERATIONS

The ability to track individual firefighters within any incident will help protect those firefighters and enhance public safety in the process.
