

**NEW HAVEN CITY PLAN COMMISSION ADVISORY REPORT**

**RE:** **ORDER OF THE BOARD OF ALDERS** Establishing a residential parking zone on Sherman Parkway (between Henry Street and Munson Street on the east side) and Munson Street (between County Street and Sherman Parkway). (Alder Steven Winter)

**ADVICE:** Approval

**BACKGROUND**

The residents in the area submitted a petition to the Board of Alders to establish a residential parking zone on the following streets: Munson St (between County St and Sherman Pkwy) and Sherman Pkwy (between Henry St and Munson St on the east side). There is demand for additional parking, especially during events at Hillhouse or local churches.

**PLANNING CONSIDERATIONS**

The establishment of a residential parking zone on Sherman Parkway (between Henry Street and Munson Street on the east side) and Munson Street (between County Street and Sherman Parkway) complies with the City's Comprehensive Plan:

**New Haven Vision 2025, Section I-10:** "Maximize the assets and infrastructure with respect to the availability of parking on city streets."

City ordinance requires any party requesting the establishment of a Residential Parking Zone (RPZ) to demonstrate that over 50% of residents on specific blocks are in favor of establishment. Alder Winter has attached a petition which includes signatures from 27 residents along Sherman Parkway and Munson Street, demonstrating compliance with this requirement.

**ADVICE**

The Commission finds the Order in the best interest of the City and recommends approval.
