The approved site plan for the construction of 70 Sachem Street, Yale University's New Residential Colleges (Murray and Franklin Colleges) includes a site plan and landscaping plan which is in conformance with City regulations. The applicant is proposing several amendments to the originally approved landscape plan (CPC Report 1557-07) which include:

- A change in location of approximately 200 shrubs along the hillside on the east side of the Farmington Canal Greenway path between Sachem Walk and Prospect Street.
- The overall number of trees was reduced by 21 and the shrubs by 30.
- Three of the eastern most, proposed street trees in front of the Theater at Sachem and Prospect Streets were not installed.

The site plan will still comply with the City's requirements after the changes.
