

NEW HAVEN CITY PLAN COMMISSION ADVISORY REPORT

RE: **ORDER OF THE BOARD OF ALDERS** Establishing a residential parking zone to include both sides of the entire length of Anthony Drive. (Alder Salvatore Decola)

REPORT: 1537-04

ADVICE: Approval

BACKGROUND

Anthony Drive is a cul de sac off of Lighthouse Road in the East Shore neighborhood. There are 10 homes on Anthony Drive. Occupants of all 10 of these homes have submitted a petition requesting that this street be turned into a residential parking zone (RPZ).

PLANNING CONSIDERATIONS

The affected street is a residential street in the East Shore neighborhood, about a quarter of a mile from the entrance to Lighthouse Point Park, which charges a parking fee during the summer months and may result in parking in the surrounding neighborhood. The Transportation, Traffic, and Parking (TTP) Department's threshold for granting an RPZ is 50 percent of residents must request one. In this case the threshold has been met.

ADVICE

The Commission finds the Order in the best interest of the City and recommends approval.
