

NEW HAVEN CITY PLAN COMMISSION ADVISORY REPORT

RE: CONNECTICUT NEIGHBORHOOD ASSISTANCE ACT 2014, Eligible Organizations (Livable City Initiative).

ADVICE: Approval

BACKGROUND:

Before the Board is a listing of eligible non-profit organizations who may apply for eligibility to receive donations under the Connecticut Neighborhood Assistance Act. State Statute requires that the list be approved by a municipal governing body prior to submission to the State Department of Revenue Services by the July 1, 2014 deadline. Business firms which sponsor approved local programs are provided with tax credits which vary in amount depending upon the population being served. Proposed programs must be submitted and conducted by non-profit agencies or municipalities to be eligible. The full list of eligible organizations is contained in the Aldermanic submission.

PLANNING CONSIDERATIONS:

As the Commission commented in previous years, it is pleased to endorse the Neighborhood Assistance Act list as this will encourage the support of various non-profit organizations in the City, with no financial commitment from the City and only a minor administrative role.

ADVICE:

The Commission therefore recommends approval.
