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1 (The Special Meeting was called to order at 6:01 2 p.m.) 3 4 CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: So it is 6:01 p.m. I am going 5 to call the Special Meeting to order. This is a Special 6 Meeting of the Board of Police Commissioners taking 7 place on Tuesday, July 26th, 2022 at 6:00 o'clock p.m. 8 The purpose of this Special Meeting, the agenda, is the consideration and vote on the recommendation from Chief 9 10 Jacobson to terminate Officer Troche, based on IA case 11 211-031. 12 My understanding is we have Attorney Dugas on, and, 13 as well as Florencio Cotto, who is with the Union. 14 Before we get into that, just wanted to give the Chief 15 an opportunity to --16 MS. DUPREY: Commissioner? 17 CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Yes, ma'am? Or should we go 18 straight to the attorney --19 MS. DUPREY: For the record, can you indicate 20 Commissioners present? 21 CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Thank you for the reminder. So 22 we have a quorum. Commissioner Ribeiro, I am here. 23 Commissioner Walker, Donald Walker; Commissioner Michael 24 Lawlor, Commissioner Darrell Brooks, and Commissioner 25 Isaias Miranda. Commissioner Meares has been excused

from the meeting.

First I should ask, I know we have an agreement, but are we looking to have this an open session, or an executive session, if there is discussion?

MR. DUGAS: Commissioner, my recommendation would be to move into executive session to discuss a personnel matter specifically regarding Officer Troche,

Christopher Troche, and I can get into some of the background and details in that executive session.

CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Okay. And Mr. Cotto, are you in agreement with that, as the Union President?

MR. DUGAS: Commissioner, I can tell you that I communicated with the Union Attorney, Mr. Segar today, and he confirmed that the employee had no objection to this discussion being in executive session.

CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Okay. All right. With that being said, then I will entertain a motion to go into executive session for the purposes of personnel issues to discuss the recommendation to terminate Officer Christopher Troche. Is there a motion?

MR. WALKER: I'll make a motion that we go into executive session to discuss the termination of Officer Christopher Troche.

MR. BROOKS: I'll second that.

CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: So for our new transcriptionist,

1 that was Commissioner Donald Walker who made the motion, and Commissioner Isaias Miranda with the second -- no 2 sorry, you didn't second? Commissioner Brooks. 3 apologies. I got it all wrong? I am so sorry. 4 5 Commissioner Lawlor and Commissioners Brooks. 6 Okay. So with that being said, any discussion? 7 Okay. All those in favor, signify by saying, aye. 8 ALL COMMISSIONERS: Aye. 9 CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Opposed? Motion carries. And I 10 will invite the Chief, Assistant Chief Zannelli, 11 Assistant Chief Ettienne, Lieutenant Colon, certainly 12 the Commissioners, CAO Rush-Kittle, Attorney Dugas and 13 Mr. Cotto and Attorney Duprey. 14 And for those of you, if you, you are more than 15 welcome to stick around, hopefully you do. But if you 16 do decide to leave, please have a pleasant evening. 17 18 (Whereupon the Board went into Executive Session 19 at 6:05 p.m.) 20 21 CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: So I will entertain a motion to 22 come out of executive session. Commissioners? 23 MR. MIRANDA: Commissioner Miranda, so moved. CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Okay. Is there a second? 24 25 MR. LAWLOR: Second, Lawlor.

1 CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Okay. Did you get that -- Ms. 2 Bergstrand? 3 COURT REPORTER: I did. Thank you. 4 CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Okay. So we have a motion and a 5 second. All those in favor signify by saying, aye. ALL COMMISSIONERS: Aye. 7 CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Abstentions? Motion carried. 8 9 (Whereupon the Board came out of Executive 10 Session at 6:26 p.m.) 11 12 CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Commissioners, we have a 13 recommendation. What is your pleasure? 14 MR. WALKER: I make a motion that we file, act on 15 Chief, Acting Chief Rush-Kittle's and Chief Jacobson's 16 recommendation for termination of Officer Christopher 17 Troche. 18 CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Okay. Before we take a 19 second, if I can, I am not sure if I can actually do it 20 as the Chair, but offer a friendly amendment to accept 21 the agreement, and also exercise our right to terminate 22 Officer Troche. If somebody wants to offer that 23 friendly amendment, since the Chair cannot. Just 24 entertain that --25 MR. WALKER: I'll offer that amendment. That we --

CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Ms. Bergstrand, I hope you got that motion, if not, we can certainly restate it for you.

So we have a motion and a second. Any, any discussion?

MR. LAWLOR: Madam Chair?

CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Yes, sir.

MR. LAWLOR: So I am relatively new as a member of the Commission, but I am led to believe this is the first time that such an agreement has been presented to the Board, so this is slightly new territory, and I think it is important to point out that there is a factual basis for the termination. We have been briefed on it during the executive session, although I won't go into the details. It also worth noting that there is ongoing public dimensions here, including a pending criminal case at GA23 in New Haven. The arrest warrants, et cetera, are all public information and have been widely available to the members of the public. I just wanted to be clear, there is a factual basis for this, and I am prepared to cast a vote based on the factual basis, together with this agreement.

CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Thank you, Commissioner Lawlor.

Anyone else? Okay. Thank you for that clarification.

Okay. If there is no further discussion, then I will take a vote and I will do a voice vote. So please state your vote as I call your name.

MR. WALKER: Do we have a second?

CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: We do. I thought we did. Did we not get a second. I thought I heard one -- yes.

Okay. Thank you.

Okay. So we will call the question, Commission Lawlor?

MR. LAWLOR: Yes.

12 CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Commissioner Walker?

MR. WALKER: Yes.

CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Commissioner Brooks?

MR. BROOKS: Yes.

16 CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Commissioner Miranda?

MR. MIRANDA: Yes.

CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: And I am a yes. So the motion carries to accept the agreement for termination, as well as to accept the recommendation of Chief Kittle and Chief Jacobson for termination. And I just want to just reiterate, as Commissioner Lawlor said, that this was warranted, as far as the Commission is concerned, based on the facts as we are aware that it is definitely public information. So thank you all.

There is no further business for this evening, so I will entertain a motion for adjournment. MR. MIRANDA: So moved. MR. BROOKS: Second. CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Okay. So I know Commissioner Miranda moved. Sorry, I didn't catch who seconded. Commission Brooks. Okay. Any further discussion? All in favor signify by saying aye. ALL COMMISSIONERS: Aye. CHAIRMAN RIBEIRO: Opposed? Motion carried. you everyone. Have a great evening. (Whereupon the Board adjourned at 6:31 p.m.)
