Project Description: ConnCAT Place at Dixwell Plaza will be a vibrant, arts-focused development providing needed services to the Dixwell and Newhallville communities in New Haven. Guided by ConnCAT's (Connecticut Center for Arts and Technology) mission to "inspire, motivate, and prepare youth and adults for educational and career advancement, through after-school arts, and job training programming," ConnCAT Place will provide needed services and increased vitality to the neighborhood.

Phase 0 – Site Enabling / Demolition & Abatement: The site consists of approximately 7.5 acres with 6 existing buildings. The project will occur in phases. The first phase, Phase 0, scope of work will consist of securing the site with temporary fencing, performing abatement and demolition of 87 Webster, a former multi-tenant retail shopping plaza (156-210 Dixwell Avenue), and 220 Dixwell Avenue. 26 Charles Street and 230 Dixwell Avenue will remain in operation under this phase of the project.
