1 carry. 2 Let me just go back. My apologies. 11	COMMISSIONER RIBEIRO: Okay. Thank you. Any
12	discussion? All right. Seeing none, all those in
13	favor, please signify by saying, aye.
14	COMMISSIONER BROOKS: Aye.
15	COMMISSIONER WALKER: Aye.
16	COMMISSIONER MIRANDA: Aye.
17	COMMISSIONER LAWLOR: Aye.
18	COMMISSIONER RIBEIRO: Opposed? Abstentions?
19	Motion carry. And, Sotonye, I trust you got all of
20	that?
21	MS. OTUNBA-PAYNE: Yes, ma'am. Thank you. Oh,
22	yes, Chair, Madam Commissioner. Thank you.
23	COMMISSIONER RIBEIRO: All right. Thank you.
24	Okay. So we'll move into the Chief's Report.
25	CHIEF JACOBSON: Yeah, there won't be a Chief's

Report -- Report this evening, ma'am. 1 2 COMMISSIONER RIBEIRO: Okay. Thank you, sir. 3 So we'll move forward into Internal Affairs Report. 4 LIEUTENANT SMITH: Good evening, Madam Chair, we are going to forego the IA Report as well. 5 6 COMMISSIONER RIBEIRO: Just for the record, the 7 Commission did receive the report. And we have reviewed it. So, but -- but thank you for that, 8 9 Lieutenant. 10 LIEUTENANT SMITH: You are welcome, ma'am. 11 Thank you. 12 COMMISSIONER RIBEIRO: All right. So we'll move 13 forward to Personnel Matters. We have three issues 14 to discuss for Personnel Matters. The first will the 15 discussion and action for the recommendation from 16 Chief Anthony Campbell, Yale Police Department, to 17 hire Candidate Officer Benny Hines, to the Yale 18 Police Department. I thought I saw Chief Campbell. 19 CHIEF CAMPBELL: Good evening, Commissioners. 20 Can you hear me? 21 COMMISSIONER RIBEIRO: Yes, we can. 22 CHIEF CAMPBELL: First and foremost, I just want 23 to thank you as the Chair of the Board of Police 24 Commissioners for having me once again. It has been 25 our goal to hire the -- the best we can from the

community. And Bennett Hines is definitely one of the best members of not just the community, but the law enforcement community.

I've known him for well over 25 years. He is a phenomenal police officer. He's gone through our entire process. I believe the commissioners or at least a few of you have had the honor and privilege of interviewing him and talking with him. And I think he will be a great asset to the Yale University Police Department. He brings with him a wealth of knowledge. And I think he'll be greatly received to the department and will help the mission of our department and this city to keep moving forward in public safety.

COMMISSINER RIBEIRO: Okay. Thank you, sir.

And, yes, the committee did have an opportunity to -to speak with Officer Hines. It was a very good and
informative interview. I don't know if Commissioner
Lawlor wanted to add anything.

COMMISSIONER LAWLOR: See if I was muted. Yeah. I was just very impressed with the officer. And as I mentioned during our -- our interview, the NHPD loss is the YPD gain. And they are lucky to get him. He had a distinguished career with NHPD and -- but the good news is he'll still be in our city. And,

1	hopefully, he'll continue to work together with his
2	former colleagues and NHPD. And I'm very confident
3	he will.
4	And, Chief Campbell, I think you made a good
5	choice here. I think this is going to really work
6	out for Yale as well.
7	COMMISSIONER RIBEIRO: Okay. Yes, I agree. At
8	some point we are going to have to tell Chief
9	Campbell to stop taking all all of our good
10	people.
11	CHIEF CAMPBELL: You are going to put a cap on
12	it. Yep.
13	COMMISSINER RIBEIRO: Yeah, I have to put a cap
14	on how many you can you can have per per year.
15	COMMISSIONER LAWLOR: Unless it's compensatory
16	draft picks or something, you know.
17	CHIEF CAMPBELL: Exactly. Right.
18	COMMISSIONER RIBEIRO: All right, thank you.
19	So, Commissioners, what is your pleasure on the
20	recommendation?
21	COMMISSIONER LAWLOR: I move we approve Chief's
22	Campbell's request to hire Officer Hines.
23	COMMISSIONER WALKER: I'll second that.
24	COMMISSIONER RIBEIRO: Okay. We have a motion
25	by Commissioner Lawlor, and a second by Commissioner

Walker. Any discussion? Seeing none, all those in 1 2 favor, please signify by saying, aye. 3 COMMISSIONER LAWLOR: Aye. 4 COMMISSIONER MIRANDA: Aye. 5 COMMISSIONER BROOKS: Aye. 6 COMMISSIONER WALKER: Aye. 7 COMMISSIONER RIBEIRO: Opposed? Motion carry. 8 Congratulations, Officer Hines. And Chief Campbell 9 and your entire department, congratulations. 10 CHIEF CAMPBELL: Thank you, Commissioners. 11 appreciate you always. Thank you. 12 COMMISSIONER RIBEIRO: Moving on to Personnel 13 Matter No. 2. Discussion and action on the 14 recommendation of Chief Karl -- Karl Jacobson to hire 15 the following candidates from Eligibility List #22-16 68. Chief? 17 CHIEF JACOBSON: Yes. So we have eight fine 18 candidates here who, if you approve, will be going to 19 the New Britain Academy. This is a very diverse 20 group. I believe they speak nine different languages 21 between them all. I'm very proud of this group. 22 This is what diversity and New Haven residents --23 there are some New Haven residents in here. And I'm 24 just very excited to present them. If you'd like, I 25 will read their names off or you guys can do it,

1 however you want to do it. 2 COMMISSIONR RIBEIRO: We are going to prefer --3 Commissioners, I know that they -- they interview 4 them or we interview them. So are there any comments? And then we can -- we can read the names 5 6 when we take the votes. Commissioners, any comments? 7 COMMISSIONER BROOKS: Not this time. 8 COMMISSIONER RIBEIRO: Okay. All right. So if 9 we have comments or questions, what is your pleasure? I'll entertain --10 COMMISSIONER LAWLOR: I --11 12 COMMISSIONER RIBEIRO: Go ahead, sorry. Commissioner --13 14 COMMISSIONER LAWLOR: I'll just move that we 15 appoint the -- the individuals on the list provided 16 by the Chief as members of New Haven Police 17 Department on -- you know, subject to their 18 completion of the academy. 19 COMMISSING RIBEIRO: Just, just I'm trying to 20 state your motion correctly. You're looking to 21 approve No. 20 Kaya Czwalinska, 22 Miosonti Hueca, 22 No. 29 Jamil Saffa, No.34 Joshua Zurita, No. 38 23 Michael Morales, No. 39 Aron Ntokaiti, No. 55 Rosa Garcia, No. 61 Franco Valcareel. And if I didn't 24

8	Eligibility List 22-68 as listed. All those in

10	COMMISSIONER LAWLOR: Aye.

12	COMMISSIONER BROOKS: Aye.

16	to the Chief and the Department.
17	Sergeant Finch, I know you and your staff did a
18	tremendous job in backgrounds to get these candidates
19	to where they are. So we thank all of you for for
20	your hard work.
21	Moving on to Personnel Matter No. 3.
22	Consideration on the recommendation from Chief Karl
23	Jacobson to terminate Officer Luis Rivera,, Internal
24	Affairs Investigation 22I-046.
25	So just so we know for the record, who will be

3	Dugas.
4	COMMISSIONER RIBEIRO: Okay. And who do we have
5	representing Officer Rivera and the union?

2	we can just be just be patient a minute because
3	it's quite a few that Eva is going to let in. So it
4	will probably take a minute or so.

8	again, everyone. Commissioners, I entertain a motion


