Redding documented that the officer investigating his accident was Officer R. Hayden. In Redding's Civilian Complaint Form, he alleged Officer R. Hayden acted biased while investigating the collision and misdescribed the accident. The Milestone video provided the necessary coverage of the actual collision and what transpired before the accident to allow the investigator to clearly determine that the vehicle at fault for this collision was Redding and that Officer R. Hayden's findings were correct and accurate.
