Summary: On September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022, Ms. Lanisha Harris filed a complaint with the Office of Internal Affairs regarding an incident that occurred on June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022. It was alleged that the initial officer showed bias or acted discriminately toward her while he was investigating an alleged assault complaint involving her two adult children. During the course of this investigation, at no time was Ofc. Valente rude, was not excessive in the manner of force used, nor did he appear to show any bias toward Harris or any other person involved in this incident. After thoroughly reviewing available reports and body-worn camera footage, the investigation was determined by a preponderance of evidence that the misconduct or malfeasance complained of did not occur.
