Summer Camp Descriptions 2024

Below you will find a brief description of each camp. Breakfast & Lunch will be provided at most sites except for: ALL Light House sites, and Eco Trowbridge. Most camps will participate in some type of STEM activity. Please check individual camp schedules for changes. Dress in comfortable clothing - shorts or pants, a T-shirt and sneakers are mandatory. For Safety: No open-toed shoes are permitted (flip-flops, Crocs, sandals, etc.) Sunscreen, insect repellant and water shoes are recommended. Your child should bring a refillable water bottle, bathing suit, swim cap and towel to camp every day.

<u>TINY TOT CAMPS (ages 5 – 7):</u> these camps are specifically dedicated to our younger campers. They will be able to participate in age-appropriate sports and activities that will include field trips, hiking, arts and crafts, swimming and going to area playgrounds/splash pads.

ECO ADVENTURE CAMP and CAMP CORAL

These camps offer a unique, challenging, and fun combination of outdoor adventure and environmental education. Participants must bring lunch and two liters of water per day. Increased challenges will provide high energy adventures that may include canoeing, team building, introduction to kayaking, snorkeling, rock climbing, hiking, swimming, and more.
