

TRAFFIC AUTHORITY MINUTES
FEBRUARY, 2020

The Traffic Authority of the City of New Haven, duly warned, met in Chambers, One Union Avenue, New Haven, Connecticut on February 11th, 2020.

The meeting was called to order at 6:09 PM, Commissioner Dawson presiding.

The minutes of the November 11th, 2019 meeting were approved.

The following items were presented:

Item 1. Request of the Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking for parking controls less than one block in length as indicated.

A. Establish RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED parking spaces.

1. In front of 175 Cedar Street..... 1 space
2. In front of 28 Clay Street..... 1 space
3. In front of 1496 E. T. Grasso Blvd..... 1 space
4. In front of 951 Elm Street..... 1 space
5. In front of 464 Ferry Street..... 1 space
6. In front of 195 Ivy Street..... 1 space
7. In front of 124 Newhall Street..... 1 space
8. In front of 176 Newhall Street..... 1 space
9. In front of 62 Revere Street..... 1 space
10. In front of 937 State Street 1 space
11. In front of 64 Stevens Street..... 1 space
12. In front of 29 White Street..... 1 space

B. Rescind RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED parking spaces.

1. In front of 300 Greenwich Avenue..... 1 space
2. In front of 422 Blatchley Avenue..... 1 space
3. In front of 43 Maltby Street..... 1 space
4. In front of 184 Peck Street..... 1 space
5. In front of 75 Warren Street..... 1 space

Approval of A. and B. is recommended.

Douglas Hausladen presented the technical report. Commissioner Smith moved to approve the item. Commissioner Walker seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by a unanimous vote.

C. Establish 15 Minute Parking, 8AM – 7PM, Mon.- Sat. regulation.

1. On the west side of side of Harper Avenue from approximately 35 feet to 115 feet north of Valley Street.(80 feet). (Request of Alder Smith).

Commissioner Ribeiro moved to amend the item to Establish NO STANDING ANYTIME regulation in place of the 15 Minute Parking regulation without time limits within the area noted in No. 1 above . Commissioner Walker seconded the amendment. The amendment was voted on and approved unanimously.

Douglas Hausladen presented the technical report. Commissioner Smith moved to approve the amended item. Commissioner Ribeiro seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by a unanimous vote.

There being no further business of the Traffic Authority, the meeting was adjourned at 6:16PM.
