Representatives of the Department of Traffic and Parking will present the following items to the Traffic Authority of the City of New Haven on July 9th, 2019.

Item 1. Request of Delphine Clyburn, Alder, Ward 20 and Steven Winter, Alder Ward 21 for establishing a BIKE LANE (northbound) on the west side of Shelton Avenue from Munson Street to Bassett Street. Approval recommended.

Item 2. Request of the Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking for parking controls less than one block in length as indicated.

A. Establish RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED parking spaces.

B. Rescind RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED parking spaces.

Approval of A. and B. is recommended.

C. Rescind NO PARKING regulation,

- 1. On the west side of side of Chestnut Street, from approximately 25 feet to 115 feet north of Franklin Street at Driveway No. 1 to former Coles site (90 feet). (Request of the neighborhood, Alder Greenberg).
- 2. On the west side of side of Chestnut Street, from approximately 260 feet to 300 feet north of Franklin Street at Driveway No. 2 to former Coles site (40 feet). (Request of the neighborhood, Alder Greenberg).

D. Establish TWO HOUR PARKING, 8AM – 7PM, Mon.- Sat. regulation.

1. On the east side of Orchard Street, from Davenport Avenue to 175 feet north of Davenport Avenue (request of Alder Hurt).

E. Relocate BUS STOP regulation.

1. Rescind BUS STOP on the west side of Concord Street, far side of Burr Street, 100 feet.
2. Establish BUS STOP on the south side of Burr Street, near side of Burr Street, 80 feet.

Approval of C. thru E. is recommended.
