

TRAFFIC AUTHORITY MINUTES
NOVEMBER, 2019

The Traffic Authority of the City of New Haven, duly warned, met in Chambers, One Union Avenue, New Haven, Connecticut on October 22nd, 2019.

The meeting was called to order at 6:08 PM, Commissioner Dawson presiding.

The minutes of the October 22nd, 2019 meeting were discussed, amended and approved.

The following items were presented:

Item 1. Request of the Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking for parking controls less than one block in length as indicated.

A. Establish RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED parking spaces.

1. In front of 42 Dorman Street..... 1 space
2. In front of 124 Elizabeth Ann Drive..... 1 space
3. In front of 707 Elm Street..... 1 space
4. In front of 274 Lloyd Street..... 1 space
5. In front of 295 Lloyd Street..... 1 space
6. In front of 228 Munson Street..... 1 space
7. In front of 41 Pope Street..... 1 space

B. Rescind RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED parking spaces.

1. In front of 123 Canner Street..... 1 space

Approval of A. and B. is recommended.

Doug Hausladen presented the technical report. Commissioner Ribeiro moved to approve the item. Commissioner Garcia seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by a unanimous vote.

C. Establish POLICE ONLY 8AM-5PM MON.- FRI., METERED PARKING, NO TIME LIMIT 5PM – 9PM regulation.

1. On the east side of Church Street in front of 141 Church Street (100 feet). Request of the Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking.
2. On the north side of Wall Street between Church Street and Orange Street at meter spaces 16214, 16216, 16218 and 16220 (80 feet.) Request of the Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking.

Approval of C. is recommended.

Doug Hausladen presented the technical report. Commissioner Ribeiro moved to approve the item. Commissioner Garcia seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by a unanimous vote.

D. Establish METERED LOADING ZONE 8AM-4PM MON.- FRI.,
METERED PARKING, NO TIME LIMIT 4PM – 9PM regulation.

1. On the east side of Temple Street between Chapel Street and Crown Street at meter spaces 11302 and 11304 (40 feet.)
Request of the Town Green District.
2. On the west side of Temple Street between Chapel Street and Crown Street at meter spaces 11307 and 11309 (40 feet.)
Request of the Town Green District.

Approval of C. is recommended.

Doug Hausladen presented the technical reports. Commissioner Walker moved to approve the items. Commissioner Garcia seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and approved by a unanimous vote.

There being no further business of the Traffic Authority, the meeting was adjourned at 6:15 PM.
