The City of New Haven is currently regulated by the State of Connecticut's Phase 2.1 ReOpen Guidelines. Much of the guidance from the Phase 2 video above still applies.

Below is a summary of Phase 2.1 regulations and references to previous ReOpen Phases where applicable:

- Restaurant table service ends by 9:30pm and must close by 10:00pm nightly
- Indoor dining up to 50% capacity and a maximum of 8 people allowed per table
- Personal services up to 75% capacity indoors with 6 ft. spacing (same as Phase 3)
- Libraries up to 75% capacity (same a Phase 3)
- Outdoor Event Venues up to 25% capacity with distancing and masks (same as Phase 2)
- Indoor Performing Arts Theaters are allowed 50% capacity with 6 ft spacing between parties and a cap of 100 people
- Indoor Recreation up to 50% capacity with distancing and masks and a cap of 100 people
- Gatherings at Commercial Venues are capped at 25 people indoor and 50 people outdoor
- Gatherings are Private Residences are capped at 10 people indoor and 10 people outdoor
- Indoor Graduations up to 50% capacity with distancing and masks and capped at 100 people
- Outdoor Graduations are up to 50% capacity with distancing and masks, no cap (Same as Phase 3)
- Indoor Religious Gatherings up to 50% capacity with distancing and masks, capped at 100 people
- Outdoor Religious Gatherings are capped at 150 people (Same as Phase 3)
