BACKGROUND

The City is looking to install sidewalks where there are currently gaps in the sidewalk network:

- 1. Installation of a sidewalk on the south side of Ford St between 38 Ford St and Sherman Pkwy.
- 2. Sherman Pkwy between W Division and Harding Pl (east side)
- Exchange St near Haven St. (part of the Mill River Trail and next to an installation planned by 3. Save the Sound)
- 4. Emerson St near Valley St.

The anticipated cost of these short sections is approximately \$25,000 in total. The Resource Allocation Committee has approved this work.

The installation of four new sidewalk sections to close gaps in the sidewalk network complies with the City's Comprehensive Plan:

New Haven Vision 2025

"Build a comprehensive and integrated bicycle and pedestrian network with the City by identifying and prioritizing the missing links and implementing solutions accordingly. Improve the quality of existing sidewalks within the Hill, Newhallville, and Dixwell neighborhoods and implement new sidewalks on City's collector streets i.e., Russell Street, Quinnipiac Avenue, lower Valley Street, and Foxon Boulevard" (Sec. V-26)
